1. Academic Admission Requirements

1.1 Curriculum plans

The international program offers two types of educational plans, each with two different tracks:

- **1.1.1 <u>Plan 1.1</u>**: Focusing on research and a dissertation to contribute new knowledge under research supervision. Applicants must possess:
 - 1.1.1.1 Bachelor's Degree of Dentistry, or its equivalent, and Master of Science or equivalent in a related area of biomedical sciences, from a university or a recognized institution; or
 - 1.1.1.2 Master of Science, or its equivalent, in a related area of biomedical sciences; or
 - 1.1.1.3 Bachelor's Degree of Dentistry, or its equivalent, from a university or recognized institution, with a minimum overall grade average of 3.50; or
 - 1.1.1.4 Bachelor's Degree of Dentistry, or its equivalent, from a university or recognized institution, with research experience in a related field and at least one publication in a refereed international journal.
- **1.1.2 <u>Plan 1.2</u>**: Emphasizing self-learning with research-based dissertation leading to publication in a high-standard international journal. Applicants must possess:
 - 1.1.2.1 Bachelor's Degree of Dentistry, or its equivalent, and Master of Science or equivalent in a related area of biomedical sciences from a university or a recognized institution; or
 - 1.1.2.2 Master of Science, or its equivalent, in a related area of biomedical sciences; or

- 1.1.2.3 Bachelor's Degree of Dentistry, or its equivalent, from a university or a recognized institution, with a minimum overall grade average of 3.50; or
- 1.1.2.4 Research experience in a related field with at least one publication in a refereed international journal, having an impact factor of at least 0.5. The applicant must present evidence that the majority of the publication is the output from his or her own work.
- **1.1.3** <u>Educational Plan 2.1</u>: Academic coursework resulting in a dissertation.

Applicants must possess:

- 1.1.3.1 Bachelor's Degree of Dentistry, or its equivalent, and Master of Science or equivalent in a related area of biomedical sciences, from a university or a recognized institution; or
- 1.1.3.2 Master of Science, or its equivalent, in a related area of biomedical sciences; or
- 1.1.3.3 Bachelor's Degree of Dentistry, or its equivalent, from a university or a recognized institution, with a minimum overall grade average of 3.50; or
- 1.1.3.4 Bachelor's Degree of Science, or its equivalent, in a related area of biomedical sciences, from a university or a recognized institution, with a minimum overall grade average of 3.50.
- **1.1.4** <u>Educational Plan 2.2</u>: Academic coursework resulting in a dissertation and training in a clinical specialty. Applicants must possess:
 - 1.1.4.1 Bachelor's Degree of Dentistry, or its equivalent, and Master of Science, or equivalent, in a related area of biomedical sciences, from a university or recognized institution; or
 - 1.1.4.2 Bachelor's Degree of Dentistry, or its equivalent, from a university or recognized institution with a minimum overall grade average of 3.50; or
 - 1.1.4.3 First-grade license to practice dentistry approved by the country in which he or she graduated.

1.2 English Proficiency Requirements

- 1.2.1 Applicants must achieve a score of must achieve a score of TOEFL (Paperbased) or TOEFL-ITP (Institutional Testing Program) or TU-GET at least 550, or level 6.5 on the IELTS, or 79 on TOEFL (Internet-based) Scores must be achieved within a two years period prior to the date of application to the program.
- 1.2.2 In case the applicant fails to meet the required English test when applied for the program, applicants must obtain the 1.2.1 score prior to the thesis examination.

All applicants must satisfy the admission requirements contained in The Regulations for Doctoral Degree Education at Thammasat University, 2018 (No. 22).
